
Please note the following in preparation for our time together:

Guidelines for Events at Redeemer

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, The Redeemer Session has put in place new safety protocols in the Redeemer building. We are providing this guide to help you know what to expect when you attend an event at Redeemer. We look forward to hosting you!

Masks: All adults and children ages 10 and up are required to wear a mask or face covering while in our facility. For your safety and that of our staff, please bring your own face coverings when attending an event.

Physical distancing: Please maintain six feet of distance between you and others while attending your event.

Spaced seating: Every other row in the Redeemer sanctuary will be left empty, and two seats will be left between families or individuals seated in the same row. If desired, two unrelated persons may also sit together.

When to stay home: Please stay home if you or anyone in your household is exhibiting or recently has been exhibiting symptoms such as fever, cough, chills, sore throat, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell or gastrointestinal symptoms. All of these have been identified by the Centers for Disease Control as potential symptoms of Covid-19. Even if you believe you know of another reason for the presence of these symptoms, please stay home out of an abundance of caution.

Restroom protocols: Both our upstairs and downstairs restrooms will be open. Only two people or one family group will be allowed in each restroom at a time. There are blue floor markers outside the restrooms to help you maintain safe social distance while waiting in line.

Hand sanitizing stations: Hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the Redeemer building. Please make use of them.

Parking: Parking for your event will be available in the RPC parking lot. Street parking and several paid lots are also available in the area around the church.

Additional guidelines: Please look for signs throughout the Redeemer building regarding other safety guidelines. Some areas of the Redeemer building may be closed during your event. For more information contact us at the church office.
